

# FINAL INSPECTION REPORT Under the *Retirement Homes Act, 2010*

## **Purpose of Inspection**

The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the Retirement Homes Act, 2010 (the "RHA").

#### **NON-COMPLIANCE**

1. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 23; Behaviour management.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

- **23. (1)** Every licensee of a retirement home shall develop and implement a written behaviour management strategy that includes,
  - (b) strategies for interventions to prevent and address resident behaviours that pose a risk to the resident or others in the home;

# **Inspection Finding**

The Licensee failed to develop and implement a written behavior management strategy for resident behavior which posed a risk to the resident.

#### **Outcome**

Corrective action scheduled to be taken by the Licensee by February 29, 2016.

2. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 62; Reassessment and revision.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

**62. (12)** The licensee shall ensure that the resident is reassessed and the plan of care reviewed and revised at least every six months and at any other time if, in the opinion of the licensee or the resident,

(b) the resident's care needs change or the care services set out in the plan are no longer necessary;

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# **Inspection Finding**

The documentation provided by the home on the day of the inspection could not verify that the resident's needs had been reassessed and no evidence was provided that behaviours which carried a risk of harm had been identified.

### Outcome

Corrective action scheduled to be taken by the Licensee by March 8, 2016.

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# **NOTICE**

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.

Section 55 of the RHA requires that the Final Inspection Report be posted in the home in a conspicuous and easily accessible location. In addition, the Licensee must ensure that copies of every Final Inspection Report from the previous two (2) years are made available in the Home, in an easily accessible location.
