#### **Purpose of Inspection**

The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the Retirement Homes Act, 2010 (the "RHA").

#### **NON-COMPLIANCE**

1. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 62; Plan of care.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

**62. (1)** When a resident commences his or her residency in a retirement home, the licensee shall, within the prescribed times, ensure that the resident is assessed and that a plan of care is developed based on the assessment and in accordance with this section and the regulations.

## **Inspection Finding**

The Licensee reported to the RHRA an incident of improper care of a resident. The inspector spoke to staff, a family member, and had reviewed records. During the collection of records, it was learned there was no assessment or plan of care for the resident. The Licensee failed to ensure the resident was assessed and that a plan of care was developed based on an assessment as required.

#### Outcome

The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by following up with the Licensee or by inspection.
