Purpose of Inspection

The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the Retirement Homes Act, 2010 (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE

1. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 67; Protection against abuse and neglect.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection:

s. 67. (1) Every licensee of a retirement home shall protect residents of the home from abuse by anyone.

Inspection Finding

On October 29, 2013, a resident physically abused another resident of the home. The Licensee failed to protect this resident from abuse. Specifically:

- The Licensee had not reassessed the aggressor in relation to the behavioural changes being exhibited
- The Licensee was made aware of the need to update the aggressor's written support plan to include behavioural interventions and coping strategies during a prior inspection in May 2013 but had failed to complete this.
- The Licensee had not consulted with the aggressor's physician or Psychiatric services as per the policies above and as recommended from a September 2013 follow up with the Halton Geriatric Mental Health Outreach Program.

Outcome

Corrective action taken.

2. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 67; Policy to promote zero tolerance.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection:

<u>s. 67. (4)</u> Without in any way restricting the generality of the duties described in subsections (1) and (2), the licensee shall ensure that there is a written policy to promote zero tolerance of abuse and neglect of residents and shall ensure that the policy is complied with.

Inspection Finding

The Licensee was aware of an incident of physical abuse occurring on October 29, 2013 between two residents of the home. The Licensee failed to complete an investigation as per their policy of Incident, Abuse, and Neglect Reporting and Abuse and Neglect Prevention and Investigation.

Outcome

Corrective action taken.
