Purpose of Inspection

The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the Retirement Homes Act, 2010 (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE

1. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 65; Obligations of licensees re staff.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection:

s. 65. (1) Every licensee of a retirement home shall ensure that all staff who work in the home, (a) Have the proper skills and qualifications to perform their duties.

Inspection Finding

On three occasions, May 20, 2014, May 22, 2014 and May 24, 2014, two PSW's made the decision to monitor a resident and give her lactulose for her constipation without a physician's order. One of the PSWs offered to send the resident to hospital but she refused.

Both PSW's assessed the resident without having the proper skills and qualifications to do so.

Outcome

Corrective action taken by the Licensee.

2. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 29; Administration of drugs or other substances.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection:

- **<u>s. 29.</u>** If one of the care services that the licensee or the staff of a retirement home provide to a resident of the home is the administration of a drug or other substance, the licensee shall ensure that,
 - (a) no drug is administered by the licensee or the staff to the resident in the home unless the drug has been prescribed for the resident by a person who is authorized to prescribe a drug under section 27 of the *Regulated Health Professions Act*, 1991.

Inspection Finding

On May 24, 2014, a staff member administered lactulose to a resident without a prescription as per the legislation.

Outcome

Corrective action taken by the Licensee.
