Purpose of Inspection
The RHRA conducts routine inspections as set out in section 77(3) of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the "RHA").


NON-COMPLIANCE
<p>1. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 65; Training.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p>65. (2) Every licensee of a retirement home shall ensure that no staff work in the home unless they have received training in,</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) the Residents' Bill of Rights; (b) the licensee's policy mentioned in subsection 67 (4) to promote zero tolerance of abuse and neglect of residents; (c) the protection afforded for whistle-blowing described in section 115; (d) the licensee's policy mentioned in subsection 68 (3) regarding the use of personal assistance services devices for residents; (f) fire prevention and safety;
<p>Inspection Finding</p> <p>Employee files for the two most recent hires were reviewed; however there was no documented proof that the employees had received the mandatory training as required by the legislation. The home was unable to provide evidence to support that all of their staff had received the required annual training.</p>
<p>Outcome</p> <p>Corrective action taken by the Licensee.</p>

NOTICE
