Purpose of Inspection
The RHRA conducts routine inspections as set out in section 77(3) of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE
<p>1. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 25; Emergency plan, retirement home with more than 10 residents.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p><u>25. (4)</u> The licensee shall ensure that the emergency plan addresses the following components:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Plan activation. 2. Lines of authority. 3. Communications plan. 4. Specific staff roles and responsibilities.
<p>Inspection Finding</p> <p>The emergency plan does not address plan activation, lines of authority, communication plan or specific staff roles and responsibilities.</p>
<p>Outcome</p> <p>Corrective action taken by the Licensee.</p>
<p>2. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 43; Initial assessment of care needs. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 44; Full assessment of care needs.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p>

43. (2) The initial assessment mentioned in subsection (1) shall consider the following matters with respect to the resident:

1. Continence.
2. Presence of infectious diseases.
3. Risk of falling.
4. Known allergies.
5. Dietary needs including known food restrictions.
6. Cognitive ability.
7. Risk of harm to self and to others.
8. Risk of wandering.
9. Needs related to drugs and other substances.

44. (2) The full assessment mentioned in subsection (1) shall consider the following matters with respect to the resident:

1. Physical and mental health.
2. Functional capacity.
3. Cognitive ability.
4. Behavioural issues.
5. Need for care services.
6. Need for assistance with the activities of daily living.
7. The matters listed in subsection 43 (2).
8. Any other matter relevant to developing a plan of care for the resident.

Inspection Finding

The home uses a Medical Records form for assessment of resident's care needs. This form does not include all of the required considerations of the initial and full assessment of the resident's care needs.

Outcome

Corrective action taken by the Licensee.

3. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 23; Behaviour management.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

- 23. (1)** Every licensee of a retirement home shall develop and implement a written behaviour management strategy that includes,
- (c) strategies for monitoring residents that have demonstrated behaviours that pose a risk to the resident or others in the home;

Inspection Finding

The Behaviour Management Policy does not include strategies for monitoring residents that have demonstrated behaviours that pose a risk.

Outcome


Corrective action required by the Licensee.

NOTICE

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.
