Purpose of Inspection
The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the "RHA").


NON-COMPLIANCE
<p>1. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 67; Policy to promote zero tolerance.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p>67. (4) Without in any way restricting the generality of the duties described in subsections (1) and (2), the licensee shall ensure that there is a written policy to promote zero tolerance of abuse and neglect of residents and shall ensure that the policy is complied with.</p>
<p>Inspection Finding</p> <p>A resident receives cash on a regular basis from their POA and keeps the cash hidden in their suite. Between September 20, 2014 and October 27, 2014, a wallet with approximately \$1050.00 went missing. The POA reported this to the home on November 5, 2014 but no investigation was conducted by the now former Director of Health and Wellness. On November 14, 2014, the POA again reported the incident to the Interim General Manager who was unaware of the initial report. The Interim GM immediately commenced an investigation. However, he did not follow the home's abuse and neglect policy when conducting the investigation.</p>
<p>Outcome</p> <p>Corrective action taken by the Licensee.</p>

NOTICE

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.
