Purpose of Inspection

<p>1. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 44; Full assessment of care needs.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p>44. (1) Subject to section 46, no later than 14 days after a resident commences residency in a retirement home, the licensee shall ensure that a full assessment of the resident's care needs and preferences is conducted.</p>
<p>Inspection Finding</p> <p>One of the resident's records showed that a resident did not have a full assessment completed within the specified time frame.</p>
<p>Outcome</p> <p>Corrective action taken by the Licensee.</p>
<p>2. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 30; Storage of drugs or other substances.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p>30. If drugs or other substances are stored in a retirement home on behalf of a resident, the licensee of the home shall ensure that,</p>

(b) controlled substances as defined in the Controlled Drugs and Substances Act (Canada) are stored in a separate, double-locked stationary cupboard in the locked area or stored in a separate locked area within the locked medication cart;

Inspection Finding

Some of the controlled substances in the home were stored according to the requirements.

Outcome


Corrective action taken by the Licensee.

NOTICE
