Purpose of Inspection

The RHRA conducts routine inspections as set out in section 77(3) of the *Retirement Homes Act, 2010* (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE

1. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 72; Trust for resident's money.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

<u>72.</u> If money is entrusted to the care of a licensee of a retirement home on behalf of a resident of the home, the licensee shall establish a trust account for the money in accordance with the rules specified in the regulations.

Inspection Finding

The Licensee failed to establish a trust account for money entrusted to the care of the Licensee on behalf of the residents.

Outcome

Corrective action taken by the Licensee.

2. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 24; Emergency plan, general.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

24. (4) The licensee shall keep current all arrangements with community agencies, partner facilities and resources that will be involved in responding to an emergency.

24. (5) The licensee shall,

- (a) on an annual basis at least, test the emergency plan, including arrangements with community agencies, partner facilities and resources that will be involved in responding to an emergency, related to,
 - (i) the loss of essential services,
 - (ii) situations involving a missing resident,
 - (iii) medical emergencies,
 - (iv) violent outbursts;
- (c) keep a written record of the testing of the emergency plan and planned evacuations and of any changes made to improve the emergency plan.

Inspection Finding

The Licensee failed to demonstrate that the emergency plan contained current arrangements with community agencies, partner facilities, and resources that would be involved in responding to an emergency. The Licensee did not keep records demonstrating that the prescribed annual tests of the emergency plan had been completed.

Outcome

Corrective action taken by the Licensee.
