Purpose of Inspection
The RHRA conducts routine inspections as set out in section 77(3) of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE
<p>1. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 24; Emergency plan, general.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p>24. (5) The licensee shall,</p> <p>(a) on an annual basis at least, test the emergency plan, including arrangements with community agencies, partner facilities and resources that will be involved in responding to an emergency, related to,</p> <p>(iii) medical emergencies,</p>
<p>Inspection Finding</p> <p>The Licensee did not demonstrate annual testing of the emergency plan related to medical emergencies.</p>
<p>Outcome</p> <p>Corrective action taken by the Licensee.</p>
<p>2. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 65; Training.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p>65. (2) Every licensee of a retirement home shall ensure that no staff work in the home unless they have received training in,</p>


<p>(d) the licensee’s policy mentioned in subsection 68 (3) regarding the use of personal assistance services devices for residents;</p>
<p>Inspection Finding</p> <p>All staff working in the home has not received training in the Licensee’s policy regarding the use of personal assistance services devices for residents.</p>
<p>Outcome</p> <p>Corrective action taken by the Licensee.</p>
<p>3. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 29; Administration of drugs or other substances.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p>29. If one of the care services that the licensee or the staff of a retirement home provide to a resident of the home is the administration of a drug or other substance, the licensee shall ensure that,</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (c) neither the licensee nor a staff member administers a drug to a resident in the home unless the licensee or the staff member has received training in the procedures applicable to the administration of the drug; (e) if the licensee or a staff member is involved in the administration of the drug or other substance at the home, that the licensee or staff member is trained in, <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) ways of reducing the incidence of infectious disease, including maintaining proper hand hygiene, (ii) the safe disposal of syringes and other sharps, (iii) recognizing an adverse drug reaction and taking appropriate action;
<p>Inspection Finding</p> <p>UCP training was not current. The Licensee did not demonstrate that staff administering medication to residents in the home has received training in the procedures applicable to the administration of the drug, ways of reducing the incidence of infectious disease, including maintaining proper hand hygiene, the safe disposal of syringes and other sharps, and recognizing an adverse drug reaction and taking appropriate action.</p>
<p>Outcome</p> <p>Corrective action taken by the Licensee.</p>
