**Purpose of Inspection** 

The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the Retirement Homes Act, 2010 (the "RHA").

### NON-COMPLIANCE

1. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 75; Reporting certain matters to Registrar.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

<u>75. (1)</u> A person who has reasonable grounds to suspect that any of the following has occurred or may occur shall immediately report the suspicion and the information upon which it is based to the Registrar:
3. Unlawful conduct that resulted in harm or a risk of harm to a resident.

### Inspection Finding

The Licensee became aware of an incident of suspected theft of a resident's purse from the home on August 21, 2015. The Licensee contacted the police, but failed to report the incident to the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority as prescribed. The suspected theft of the resident's purse was attributed to an individual who was not associated with the Retirement Home or the Licensee.

### Outcome

Corrective action taken by the Licensee.



# NOTICE

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.
