Purpose of Inspection
The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the "RHA").


NON-COMPLIANCE
<p>1. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 40; Provision of a meal.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p>40. If one of the care services that the licensee or the staff of a retirement home provide to a resident of the home is the provision of a meal, the licensee shall ensure that,</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) if the licensee is the sole provider of the resident's meals, the resident is offered at least three meals per day at reasonable and regular meal hours, a beverage between the morning and midday meals, a snack and a beverage between the midday and evening meals and a snack and a beverage after the evening meal; (b) menus provide adequate nutrients, fibre and energy for the resident, include fresh seasonal foods and are consistent with standards of good nutrition in Canada; (c) the menu is varied and changes daily; (d) the menu cycle changes at least every 21 days; (e) the menu includes alternative entrée choices at each meal; (g) the resident is informed of his or her daily and weekly menu options;
<p>Inspection Finding</p> <p>One of the care services that the retirement home provides to residents of the home is the provision of a meal. The licensee did not ensure that the legislative requirements related to provision of a meal are being met as listed.</p>
<p>Outcome</p> <p>Corrective action scheduled to be completed by the Licensee by November 26, 2015.</p>

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.
