Purpose of Inspection
The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE

The resident or the resident's substitute decision-maker.</p> <p>62. (12) The licensee shall ensure that the resident is reassessed and the plan of care reviewed and revised at least every six months and at any other time if, in the opinion of the licensee or the resident,</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">(b) the resident's care needs change or the care services set out in the plan are no longer necessary;</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">(c) the care services set out in the plan have not been effective.</p>
<p>Inspection Finding</p> <p>During an inspection, a resident's plan of care was reviewed and shown not to have been updated following changes in the resident's care needs. Furthermore, there was no evidence that the resident's substitute decision makers participated in the development of the plan of care or when revisions were made.</p>
<p>Outcome</p> <p>Corrective action taken by the Licensee.</p>
