Purpose of Inspection
The RHRA conducts routine inspections as set out in section 77(3) of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE
<p>1. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 43; Initial assessment of care needs. The Licensee failed to comply with O. <p>Inspection Finding</p> <p>The Licensee had evidence of completing assessments however the required elements listed had not been included in the assessment.</p>
<p>Outcome</p> <p>Corrective action scheduled to be completed by the Licensee by February 26, 2016.</p>
<p>2. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 23; Behaviour management.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p>

23. (1) Every licensee of a retirement home shall develop and implement a written behaviour management strategy that includes,

- (a) techniques to prevent and address resident behaviours that pose a risk to the resident or others in the home;
- (b) strategies for interventions to prevent and address resident behaviours that pose a risk to the resident or others in the home;
- (c) strategies for monitoring residents that have demonstrated behaviours that pose a risk to the resident or others in the home;

Inspection Finding

The Licensee's written behaviour management strategy was not personalized to include the Licensee's processes used.

Outcome


Corrective action scheduled to be completed by the Licensee by February 26, 2016.

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.
