### **Purpose of Inspection**

The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the Retirement Homes Act, 2010 (the "RHA").

## NON-COMPLIANCE

## 1. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 67; Same, neglect.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

**67. (2)** Every licensee of a retirement home shall ensure that the licensee and the staff of the home do not neglect the residents.

#### **Inspection Finding**

The Licensee had certain procedures in place to monitor the water temperature in the home. These procedures outlined what is to be done when the water temperature reaches an unsafe level. Inspection revealed that staff at the home were not following these procedures, despite water temperature being consistently over the maximum set by the Licensee's policy. The Licensee failed to have controls in place to ensure that staff at the home took prompt action to reduce water temperature during March 2016. The Licensee's inaction jeopardized the safety and well-being of one or more residents.

#### Outcome

The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance.



# NOTICE

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.

Section 55 of the RHA requires that the Final Inspection Report be posted in the home in a conspicuous and easily accessible location.
