Purpose of Inspection
The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the "RHA").


NON-COMPLIANCE
<p>1. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 62; Contents of plan.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p>62. (4) The licensee of a retirement home shall ensure that there is a written plan of care for each resident of the home that sets out,</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) the care services that are part of a package of care services that the resident is entitled to receive under the resident's agreement with the licensee, whether or not the resident receives the services; (b) the planned care services for the resident that the licensee will provide, including, <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) the details of the services, (ii) the goals that the services are intended to achieve, (iii) clear directions to the licensee's staff who provide direct care to the resident;
<p>Inspection Finding</p> <p>The plan of care for a resident did not include dementia care as a care service, as well as the details of that care service, the goals that service was intended to achieve, and clear directions to the staff who provide direct care to the resident.</p>
<p>Outcome</p> <p>The Licensee submitted plan to achieve compliance by July 31, 2016. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.</p>

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.
