## **Purpose of Inspection**

## NON-COMPLIANCE

# 1. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 30; Storage of drugs or other substances.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

<u>30.</u> If drugs or other substances are stored in a retirement home on behalf of a resident, the licensee of the home shall ensure that,

(c) an audit of the controlled substances mentioned in clause (b) is performed monthly.

## Inspection Finding

The home was not consistently completing a monthly audit of the controlled substances.

#### Outcome

The Licensee took corrective action to achieve compliance.



# NOTICE

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.
