Purpose of Inspection

The RHRA conducts compliance inspections as set out in section 77(1) of the *Retirement Homes Act, 2010* (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE

1. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 65; Training.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

65. (2) Every licensee of a retirement home shall ensure that no staff work in the home unless they have received training in,

(h) the emergency plan and the infection prevention and control program of the licensee for the home mentioned in subsection 60 (4);

Inspection Finding

The Licensee provided evidence of training for new hires in the Licensee's training regarding the infection and prevention control program, however no evidence was presented to demonstrate ongoing training was completed for all staff, as prescribed.

Outcome

The Licensee took corrective action to achieve compliance.

 The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 62; Involvement of resident, etc.. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 62; Persons who approve plans of care.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

62. (5) The licensee shall ensure that the resident, the resident's substitute decision-maker, if any, and any other persons designated by the resident or substitute decision-maker are given an opportunity to participate in the development, implementation and reviews of the resident's plan of care.

62. (9) The licensee shall ensure that the following persons have approved the plan of care, including any revisions to it, and that a copy is provided to them:

1. The resident or the resident's substitute decision-maker.

Inspection Finding

The Licensee did not provide evidence that, in preparing plans of care for all residents, the Licensee had taken action to: (a) Ensure that the resident and the resident's substitute decision-maker (if any) were given an opportunity to be involved in the development, implementation and reviews of the resident's plan of care, and (b) Ensure that the resident or the resident's substitute decision-maker have approved the plan of care or any revision to the resident's plan of care

Outcome

The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.



NOTICE

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.

Section 55 of the RHA requires that the Final Inspection Report be posted in the home in a conspicuous and easily accessible location. In addition, the Licensee must ensure that copies of every Final Inspection Report from the previous two (2) years are made available in the Home, in an easily accessible location.
