Purpose of Inspection
The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE
<p><b>1. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 30; Storage of drugs or other substances.</b></p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p><b>30.</b> If drugs or other substances are stored in a retirement home on behalf of a resident, the licensee of the home shall ensure that,</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">(a) the drugs or other substances are stored in an area or a medication cart that,</p> <p style="padding-left: 80px;">(ii) is locked and secure,</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">(b) controlled substances as defined in the Controlled Drugs and Substances Act (Canada) are stored in a separate, double-locked stationary cupboard in the locked area or stored in a separate locked area within the locked medication cart;</p>
<p><b>Inspection Finding</b></p> <p>The Licensee failed to store drugs and other substances in an area that was locked and secured. Further, the Licensee failed to store controlled substances in a separate, double-locked stationary cupboard or locked area.</p>
<p><b>Outcome</b></p> <p>The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.</p>
<p><b>2. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 65; Additional training for direct care staff.</b></p> <p><b>The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 14; Staff training.</b></p>

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

**65. (5)** The licensee shall ensure that all staff who provide care services to residents receive training in the following matters and at the times required by the regulations, as a condition of continuing to have contact with residents, in addition to the other training that they are required to receive under this section:

5. All other prescribed matters.

**14. (3)** For the purposes of paragraph 5 of subsection 65 (5) of the Act, every licensee of a retirement home shall ensure that every staff member who provides a care service to a resident has received or receives training in,

(b) each care service offered in the home so that the staff member is able to understand the general nature of each of those services, the standards applicable under the Act to each of those services and the aspects of each of those services that may be relevant to the staff member's own duties in the home.

**14. (5)** The licensee shall ensure that the persons who are required to receive the training described in subsection 65 (5) of the Act receive that training on an ongoing basis, namely at least annually after receiving the training described in subsection (4).

**Inspection Finding**

The Licensee has not provided the prescribed training annually to those staff members that provide direct care services, specifically for; assistance with bathing, assistance with personal hygiene, assistance with ambulation, continence care and assistance with dressing.

**Outcome**

The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.

**NOTICE**

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.

Section 55 of the RHA requires that the Final Inspection Report be posted in the home in a conspicuous and easily accessible location. In addition, the Licensee must ensure that copies of every Final Inspection Report from the previous two (2) years are made available in the Home, in an easily accessible location.
