Purpose of Inspection
The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE
<p>1. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 40; Provision of a meal.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p>40. If one of the care services that the licensee or the staff of a retirement home provide to a resident of the home is the provision of a meal, the licensee shall ensure that,</p> <p>(g) the resident is informed of his or her daily and weekly menu options;</p>
<p>Inspection Finding</p> <p>The Licensee did not inform the residents of their weekly menu options.</p>
<p>Outcome</p> <p>The Licensee took corrective action to achieve compliance.</p>
<p>2. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 20; Food preparation.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p>20. (4) The licensee shall ensure that whenever food is prepared in the retirement home, at least one person involved in preparing the food holds a current certificate in food handling from the local public health unit or has recently successfully completed a food handling training program equivalent to that offered by public health units.</p>
<p>Inspection Finding</p> <p>The person preparing the food during the inspection did not hold a current certificate in food handling.</p>

Outcome


The Licensee has submitted a plan to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.
