Purpose of Inspection

The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the Retirement Homes Act, 2010 (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE

1. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 67; Policy to promote zero tolerance.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

<u>67. (4)</u> Without in any way restricting the generality of the duties described in subsections (1) and (2), the licensee shall ensure that there is a written policy to promote zero tolerance of abuse and neglect of residents and shall ensure that the policy is complied with.

Inspection Finding

Between October 2016 and April 2017, 8 residents reported that money, jewelry and/or property had been stolen. The Licensee has a policy to promote zero tolerance of abuse and neglect and failed to follow the investigative procedures as outlined within the policy.

Outcome

The Licensee took corrective action to achieve compliance.

2. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 75; Reporting certain matters to Registrar.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

75. (1) A person who has reasonable grounds to suspect that any of the following has occurred or may occur shall immediately report the suspicion and the information upon which it is based to the Registrar:

4. Misuse or misappropriation of a resident's money.

Inspection Finding

The Licensee failed to immediately report to the Registrar financial abuse involving 8 residents.

Outcome

The Licensee took corrective action to achieve compliance.
