Purpose of Inspection

<p>Inspection Finding</p> <p>A staff in the home had not received annual training in the home's abuse policy as required.</p>
<p>Outcome</p> <p>The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.</p>
