Purpose of Inspection
The RHRA conducts routine inspections as set out in section 77(3) of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the "RHA").

<p>Inspection Finding</p> <p>During the inspection the Licensee was unable to show that all staff who provide care services to residents received the prescribed training for behaviour management.</p>
<p>Outcome</p> <p>The Licensee must take corrective action to achieve compliance.</p>
<p>2. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 55; Contents of records.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p>55. (2) The record for each resident shall include,</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">(d) a copy of the resident's most recent plan of care;</p>

Inspection Finding

During the inspection, the Licensee was unable to show that 3 resident records contained their most current plan of care.

Outcome

The Licensee must take corrective action to achieve compliance.

NOTICE

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.

Section 55 of the RHA requires that the Final Inspection Report be posted in the home in a conspicuous and easily accessible location.
