Purpose of Inspection

(4) Without in any way restricting the generality of the duties described in subsections (1) and (2), the licensee shall ensure that there is a written policy to promote zero tolerance of abuse and neglect of residents and shall ensure that the policy is complied with.</p>
<p>Inspection Finding</p> <p>The Licensee did not take steps to ensure that the non-abuse policy of the Home was fully complied with.</p>
<p>Outcome</p> <p>The Licensee took corrective action to achieve compliance.</p>
