**Purpose of Inspection** 

The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the Retirement Homes Act, 2010 (the "RHA").

## NON-COMPLIANCE

1. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 29; Administration of drugs or other substances.

### The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 32; Records.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

**<u>29.</u>** If one of the care services that the licensee or the staff of a retirement home provide to a resident of the home is the administration of a drug or other substance, the licensee shall ensure that,

(b) no drug is administered by the licensee or the staff to the resident in the home except in accordance with the directions for use specified by the person who prescribed the drug for the resident;

<u>32.</u> If the licensee or a member of the staff of a retirement home administers a drug or other substance to a resident, the licensee shall ensure that,

(b) if a drug is administered, there is written evidence that the drug was prescribed for the resident by a person who is authorized to prescribe a drug under section 27 of the Regulated Health Professions Act, 1991;

#### **Inspection Finding**

The Licensee did not ensure that there was written evidence that a drug was prescribed for one resident. Further, the Licensee did not ensure that the same drug was administered to the same resident in accordance with the directions for use.

#### Outcome

The Licensee submitted plan to achieve compliance by December 30, 2017. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.



2. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 62; Contents of plan. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 62; Assessment of resident.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

**62. (4)** The licensee of a retirement home shall ensure that there is a written plan of care for each resident of the home that sets out,

- (b) the planned care services for the resident that the licensee will provide, including,
  - (i) the details of the services,
  - (ii) the goals that the services are intended to achieve,
  - (iii) clear directions to the licensee's staff who provide direct care to the resident;

**62. (6)** The licensee shall ensure that the plan of care is based on an assessment of the resident and the needs and preferences of the resident.

#### **Inspection Finding**

The plans of care that were reviewed for three residents do not meet the legislative requirements. Specifically, the plans of care lack details and clear directions to staff and are not always based on an assessment of the resident's care needs.

#### Outcome

The Licensee has advised that it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.



# NOTICE

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.

Section 55 of the RHA requires that the Final Inspection Report be posted in the home in a conspicuous and easily accessible location. In addition, the Licensee must ensure that copies of every Final Inspection Report from the previous two (2) years are made available in the Home, in an easily accessible location.
