

# FINAL INSPECTION REPORT Under the Retirement Homes Act, 2010

## **Purpose of Inspection**

The RHRA conducts routine inspections as set out in section 77(3) of the *Retirement Homes Act, 2010* (the "RHA").

#### **NON-COMPLIANCE**

1. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 24; Emergency plan, general.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

- 24. (5) The licensee shall,
  - (a) on an annual basis at least, test the emergency plan, including arrangements with community agencies, partner facilities and resources that will be involved in responding to an emergency, related to,
    - (i) the loss of essential services,
    - (ii) situations involving a missing resident,
    - (iii) medical emergencies,
    - (iv) violent outbursts;
  - (c) keep a written record of the testing of the emergency plan and planned evacuations and of any changes made to improve the emergency plan.

## **Inspection Finding**

At the time of the inspection, the Administrator confirmed that annual testing of the emergency plan for loss of essential services, missing resident, medical emergencies, and violent outbursts was not completed in 2016 and no records of the testing and changes made to improve the system were made, as prescribed.

#### **Outcome**

The Licensee took corrective action to achieve compliance.

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2. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 65; On-going training. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 14; Staff training.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

<u>65. (4)</u> The licensee shall ensure that the persons who are required to receive the training described in subsection (2) receive on-going training as described in that subsection at the times required by the regulations.

14. (1) For the purposes of clause 65 (2) (j) of the Act, every licensee of a retirement home shall ensure that all staff who work in the home receive training in the procedure described in subsection 73 (1) of the Act for a person to complain to the licensee.

### **Inspection Finding**

At the time of the inspection, a sample of six staff training records were inspected. There was insufficient evidence to demonstrate that each staff member had completed all of the training as prescribed, including training for new staff and ongoing training.

#### **Outcome**

The Licensee submitted a plan to achieve corrective action by December 31, 2017. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.

3. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 67; Contents.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

**67. (5)** At a minimum, the policy to promote zero tolerance of abuse and neglect of residents shall, (a) clearly set out what constitutes abuse and neglect;

## **Inspection Finding**

The definition of "neglect" found in the Licensee's Policy to Promote Zero Tolerance of Abuse and Neglect was found not to be aligned with the legislation.

#### Outcome

The Licensee took corrective action to achieve compliance.

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#### **NOTICE**

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.

Section 55 of the RHA requires that the Final Inspection Report be posted in the home in a conspicuous and easily accessible location. In addition, the Licensee must ensure that copies of every Final Inspection Report from the previous two (2) years are made available in the Home, in an easily accessible location.
