The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the "RHA").


NON-COMPLIANCE
<p>1. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 62; Involvement of resident, etc..</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s): 62. (5) The licensee shall ensure that the resident, the resident's substitute decision-maker, if any, and any other persons designated by the resident or substitute decision-maker are given an opportunity to participate in the development, implementation and reviews of the resident's plan of care.</p>
<p>Inspection Finding</p> <p>There was no evidence to indicate that the substitute decision maker was given an opportunity to participate in the plan of care.</p>
<p>Outcome</p> <p>The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.</p>
<p>2. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 62; Reassessment and revision.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s): 62. (12) The licensee shall ensure that the resident is reassessed and the plan of care reviewed and revised at least every six months and at any other time if, in the opinion of the licensee or the resident, (b) the resident's care needs change or the care services set out in the plan are no longer necessary;</p>
<p>Inspection Finding</p> <p>There was no evidence that revisions were made to the plan of care to reflect current changes to care as required in the legislation.</p>
<p>Outcome</p> <p>The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.</p>
