Purpose of Inspection

The RHRA conducts routine inspections as set out in section 77(3) of the *Retirement Homes Act, 2010* (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE

1. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 65; On-going training.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

<u>65. (4)</u> The licensee shall ensure that the persons who are required to receive the training described in subsection (2) receive on-going training as described in that subsection at the times required by the regulations.

Inspection Finding

While the Licensee maintained records for ongoing staff training, those records did not include evidence of annual training in the Residents' Bill of Rights, as prescribed.

Outcome

The Licensee must take corrective action to achieve compliance.

2. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 24; Emergency plan, general.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

24. (4) The licensee shall keep current all arrangements with community agencies, partner facilities and resources that will be involved in responding to an emergency.

Inspection Finding

At the time of inspection, the Licensee did not have evidence of current arrangements for transportation of the residents from the Home in the event of an emergency.

Outcome

The Licensee took corrective action to achieve compliance.

3. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 62; Persons who approve plans of care.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

- <u>62. (9)</u> The licensee shall ensure that the following persons have approved the plan of care, including any revisions to it, and that a copy is provided to them:
 - 1. The resident or the resident's substitute decision-maker.

Inspection Finding

At the time of inspection, the Licensee did not have evidence that the plans of care for all residents were approved by the resident, or their substitute decision-maker, and that a copy was provided to them, as prescribed.

Outcome

The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.
