Purpose of Inspection
The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE
<p>1. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 67; Policy to promote zero tolerance.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p>67. (4) Without in any way restricting the generality of the duties described in subsections (1) and (2), the licensee shall ensure that there is a written policy to promote zero tolerance of abuse and neglect of residents and shall ensure that the policy is complied with.</p>
<p>Inspection Finding</p> <p>The Licensee had received an allegation of sexual abuse involving a resident of the home. During the inspection the Licensee was unable to show that the home had complied with their Zero Tolerance of Abuse and Neglect policy. Specifically; the Licensee did not immediately notify the resident Substitute Decision Maker and/or Power of Attorney of the incident. Further, the same incident was reported as a criminal matter and the police were not immediately notified.</p>
<p>Outcome</p> <p>The Licensee submitted a plan to achieve compliance by May 1, 2018. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.</p>
<p>2. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 62; Persons who approve plans of care.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p>

62. (9) The licensee shall ensure that the following persons have approved the plan of care, including any revisions to it, and that a copy is provided to them:

1. The resident or the resident’s substitute decision-maker.

Inspection Finding

During the inspection the Licensee was unable to show that residents/substitute decision makers and/or Power of Attorney had participated and approved the resident plan of care.

Outcome

The Licensee submitted a plan to achieve compliance by June 1, 2018. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.

NOTICE

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the “RHRA”) and the home’s Residents’ Council, if any.

Section 55 of the RHA requires that the Final Inspection Report be posted in the home in a conspicuous and easily accessible location. In addition, the Licensee must ensure that copies of every Final Inspection Report from the previous two (2) years are made available in the Home, in an easily accessible location.
