Purpose of Inspection
The RHRA conducts routine inspections as set out in section 77(3) of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE
<p><b>1. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 54; Contents.</b></p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p><b>54. (2)</b> The package of information shall include, at a minimum, (d) the licensee's procedure for complaints mentioned in subsection 73 (1);</p>
<p><b>Inspection Finding</b></p> <p>The information package presented to new residents did not contain the Licensee's complaints procedure as required by the Act.</p>
<p><b>Outcome</b></p> <p>The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.</p>
<p><b>2. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 24; Emergency plan, general. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 25; Emergency plan, retirement home with more than 10 residents.</b></p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p><b>24. (5)</b> The licensee shall,</p>

- (a) on an annual basis at least, test the emergency plan, including arrangements with community agencies, partner facilities and resources that will be involved in responding to an emergency, related to,
  - (i) the loss of essential services,
  - (ii) situations involving a missing resident,
  - (iii) medical emergencies,
  - (iv) violent outbursts;
- (c) keep a written record of the testing of the emergency plan and planned evacuations and of any changes made to improve the emergency plan.

**25. (3)** The licensee shall ensure that the emergency plan provides for the following:

- 3. Resources, supplies and equipment vital for the emergency response being set aside and readily available at the retirement home and regular testing of all such resources, supplies and equipment to ensure that they are in working order.

**Inspection Finding**

The emergency plan presented at the inspection did not contain proof that the home's emergency supplies were being regularly tested. Further, the annual emergency drills had not been completed.

**Outcome**

The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.

**3. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 27; Infection prevention and control program.**

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

**27. (2)** The licensee shall consult on an ongoing basis and not less than once a year with the local medical officer of health or designate about identifying and addressing health care issues in the retirement home in order to reduce the incidence of infectious disease outbreaks in the home.

**27. (3)** The licensee shall keep a written record of the consultation required under subsection (2) that shall include a record of when the consultation took place, what was discussed and any recommendations that the local medical officer of health or designate made.

**Inspection Finding**

At the time of the inspection, the Licensee could not produce evidence of a consultation with the local Public Health.

**Outcome**

The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.

**4. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 43; Initial assessment of care needs.**

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

**43. (2)** The initial assessment mentioned in subsection (1) shall consider the following matters with respect to the resident:

- 3. Risk of falling.

**Inspection Finding**

At the time of the inspection, the form identified as the current resident assessment, did not address the resident's risk of falling.

**Outcome**

The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.

**5. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 30; Storage of drugs or other substances.**

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

**30.** If drugs or other substances are stored in a retirement home on behalf of a resident, the licensee of the home shall ensure that,

- (a) the drugs or other substances are stored in an area or a medication cart that,
  - (i) is used exclusively for drugs or other substances and for supplies related to drugs or other substances,

**Inspection Finding**

At the time of the inspection, a refrigerator dedicated to the storage of medication items, contained items that were not drugs.

**Outcome**

The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.

**6. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 55; Contents of records.**

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

**55. (2)** The record for each resident shall include,

- (d) a copy of the resident's most recent plan of care;

**Inspection Finding**

One resident file, reviewed during the inspection, did not contain a plan of care.

**Outcome**


The Licensee submitted plan to achieve compliance by December 31, 2018. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.

**NOTICE**

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.

Section 55 of the RHA requires that the Final Inspection Report be posted in the home in a conspicuous and easily accessible location. In addition, the Licensee must ensure that copies of every Final Inspection Report from the previous two (2) years are made available in the Home, in an easily accessible location.
