Purpose of Inspection
The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE
<p>1. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 67; Same, neglect.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p>67. (2) Every licensee of a retirement home shall ensure that the licensee and the staff of the home do not neglect the residents.</p>
<p>Inspection Finding</p> <p>A resident of the Home was neglected by staff. Specifically, staff failed to accurately ensure the resident's well-being by following the meal census policy established for this purpose.</p>
<p>Outcome</p> <p>The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.</p>
<p>2. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 14; Staff training.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p>14. (3) For the purposes of paragraph 5 of subsection 65 (5) of the Act, every licensee of a retirement home shall ensure that every staff member who provides a care service to a resident has received or receives training in,</p> <p>(b) each care service offered in the home so that the staff member is able to understand the general nature of each of those services, the standards applicable under the Act to each of those services and the aspects of each of those services that may be relevant to the staff member's own duties in the home.</p>

Inspection Finding

The Licensee failed to ensure that a staff member received training in the meal census policy of the Home.

Outcome

The Licensee submitted a plan to achieve compliance by April 22, 2019. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.

NOTICE

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.

Section 55 of the RHA requires that the Final Inspection Report be posted in the home in a conspicuous and easily accessible location. In addition, the Licensee must ensure that copies of every Final Inspection Report from the previous two (2) years are made available in the Home, in an easily accessible location.
