Purpose of Inspection

The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the Retirement Homes Act, 2010 (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE

1. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 67; Policy to promote zero tolerance.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

<u>67. (4)</u> Without in any way restricting the generality of the duties described in subsections (1) and (2), the licensee shall ensure that there is a written policy to promote zero tolerance of abuse and neglect of residents and shall ensure that the policy is complied with.

Inspection Finding

The evidence presented for inspection indicated that the Licensee's non-abuse policy was not complied with in a case of verbal abuse of a resident. Specifically, the resident was not interviewed, the next-of-kin was not immediately notified of the abuse, supports were not offered to the resident following the abuse, and the incident was not immediately reported to the Registrar of the RHRA, as prescribed.

Outcome

The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.

2. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 65; On-going training.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

<u>65. (4)</u> The licensee shall ensure that the persons who are required to receive the training described in subsection (2) receive on-going training as described in that subsection at the times required by the regulations.

Inspection Finding

At the time of the inspection there was no evidence to confirm that a staff member had completed training in 2018 on the non-abuse policy of the Home.

Outcome

The Licensee took corrective action to achieve compliance.
