Purpose of Inspection
The RHRA conducts routine inspections as set out in section 77(3) of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE
<p><b>1. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 54; Contents.</b></p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p><b>54. (2)</b> The package of information shall include, at a minimum, (k) an itemized list of the different types of accommodation and care services provided in the retirement home and their prices;</p>
<p><b>Inspection Finding</b></p> <p>The package of information given to new residents did not include a list of all care services available to residents at this retirement home.</p>
<p><b>Outcome</b></p> <p>The Licensee must take corrective action to achieve compliance.</p>
<p><b>2. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 24; Emergency plan, general. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 25; Emergency plan, retirement home with more than 10 residents.</b></p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p><b>24. (5)</b> The licensee shall, (b) at least once every two years, conduct a planned evacuation of the retirement home;</p>

**25. (5)** The licensee shall ensure that the emergency plan for the retirement home is evaluated and updated at least annually and that the updating includes contact information for the relevant community agencies, partner facilities and resources that will be involved in responding to an emergency.

**Inspection Finding**

The emergency plan presented at the inspection did not contain evidence of a full building evacuation. Further, there was no documentation to indicate the emergency plan had been reviewed and updated annually.

**Outcome**

The Licensee must take corrective action to achieve compliance.

**NOTICE**

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.

Section 55 of the RHA requires that the Final Inspection Report be posted in the home in a conspicuous and easily accessible location. In addition, the Licensee must ensure that copies of every Final Inspection Report from the previous two (2) years are made available in the Home, in an easily accessible location.
