Purpose of Inspection

The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the Retirement Homes Act, 2010 (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE

1. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 22; Risk of falls.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

22. (1) Every licensee of a retirement home shall develop, document and implement strategies to reduce or mitigate the risk of falls in common areas of the home.

Inspection Finding

The evidence showed the home failed to fully implement the directives of their falls policy for a resident who has had several falls. Specifically, the home failed to complete falls risk assessments when needed and failed to develop and implement strategies and interventions to mitigate the resident's falls.

Outcome

The Licensee submitted a plan to achieve compliance by November 15, 2019. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.

2. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 65; Training.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

<u>65. (2)</u> Every licensee of a retirement home shall ensure that no staff work in the home unless they have received training in,

(a) the Residents' Bill of Rights;

(b) the licensee's policy mentioned in subsection 67 (4) to promote zero tolerance of abuse and



neglect of residents;

(c) the protection afforded for whistle-blowing described in section 115;

(d) the licensee's policy mentioned in subsection 68 (3) regarding the use of personal assistance services devices for residents;

(e) injury prevention;

(f) fire prevention and safety;

(g) the licensee's emergency evacuation plan for the home mentioned in subsection 60 (3);

(h) the emergency plan and the infection prevention and control program of the licensee for the home mentioned in subsection 60 (4);

Inspection Finding

The Licensee failed to ensure all individuals working in the home have completed the required training.

Outcome

The Licensee submitted a plan to achieve compliance by November 1, 2019. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.
