Purpose of Inspection
The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE
<p>1. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 67; Policy to promote zero tolerance.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p>67. (4) Without in any way restricting the generality of the duties described in subsections (1) and (2), the licensee shall ensure that there is a written policy to promote zero tolerance of abuse and neglect of residents and shall ensure that the policy is complied with.</p>
<p>Inspection Finding</p> <p>The home failed to provide evidence that the abuse policy was adhered to following a report of alleged theft.</p>
<p>Outcome</p> <p>The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.</p>
<p>2. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 65; Training.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p>65. (2) Every licensee of a retirement home shall ensure that no staff work in the home unless they have received training in,</p> <p>(b) the licensee's policy mentioned in subsection 67 (4) to promote zero tolerance of abuse and neglect of residents;</p>

Inspection Finding

The home failed to provide evidence that training of staff was aligned with the requirements of the legislation.

Outcome


The Licensee submitted a plan to achieve compliance by November 30, 2019. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.

NOTICE

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.
