Purpose of Inspection
The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE
<p>1. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 32; Records.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p>32. If the licensee or a member of the staff of a retirement home administers a drug or other substance to a resident, the licensee shall ensure that,</p> <p>(a) the person who administered the drug or other substance prepares a written record noting the name and amount of the drug or other substance, the route of its administration and the time and date on which it was administered;</p>
<p>Inspection Finding</p> <p>The medication administration records for the previous 6 weeks for various residents were inspected and showed that in many instances the administration medications were not signed for by staff.</p>
<p>Outcome</p> <p>The Licensee submitted a plan to achieve compliance by December 10, 2019. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.</p>
<p>2. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 62; Reassessment and revision.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p>62. (12) The licensee shall ensure that the resident is reassessed and the plan of care reviewed and revised at least every six months and at any other time if, in the opinion of the licensee or the resident,</p>

Inspection Finding

A sample of resident plans of care were inspected. Several were found to be overdue for review and revision, as prescribed under the Act.

Outcome

The Licensee submitted a plan to achieve compliance by December 18, 2019. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.
