## **Purpose of Inspection**

The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the Retirement Homes Act, 2010 (the "RHA").

## **NON-COMPLIANCE**

1. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 73; Requirements for procedure.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

73. (2) The procedure shall comply with the regulations.

# **Inspection Finding**

The Licensee's complaint procedure does not comply with the requirements set out in the Regulation. Specifically, the procedure does not set out the process or timelines for complaints that can not be investigated and resolved within 10 business days, as described in O. Reg., s. 59 (1) 3.

#### **Outcome**

The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.

2. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 62; Compliance with plan.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

**62. (10)** The licensee shall ensure that the care services that the licensee provides to the resident are set out in the plan of care and are provided to the resident in accordance with the plan and the prescribed requirements, if any.

## **Inspection Finding**

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The plan of care for a resident set out specific requirements for toileting, however at the inspection the Licensee was not able to demonstrate that this resident's care service was provided to the resident as described in the plan.

## **Outcome**

The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.
