Purpose of Inspection

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

27. (5) The licensee of a retirement home shall ensure that,

(0.a) any guidance, advice or recommendations given to retirement homes by the Chief Medical Officer of Health are followed in the retirement home;

Inspection Finding

The Licensee failed to follow recommendations given to retirement homes by the Chief Medical Officer of Health and failed to take reasonable steps to follow directives with respect to coronavirus (COVID-19) from the Chief Medical Officer of Health.

Outcome

The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.
