Purpose of Inspection
The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE
<p>1. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 67; Policy to promote zero tolerance.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p>67. (4) Without in any way restricting the generality of the duties described in subsections (1) and (2), the licensee shall ensure that there is a written policy to promote zero tolerance of abuse and neglect of residents and shall ensure that the policy is complied with.</p>
<p>Inspection Finding</p> <p>The evidence did not show the Licensee's written policy to promote zero tolerance of abuse and neglect of residents had been fully complied with in relation to an allegation of physical abuse.</p>
<p>Outcome</p> <p>The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.</p>
<p>2. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 27; Infection prevention and control program.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p>27. (5) The licensee of a retirement home shall ensure that,</p> <p>(0.b) all reasonable steps are taken in the retirement home to follow,</p> <p>(i) any directive respecting coronavirus (COVID-19) issued to long-term care homes by the Chief Medical Officer of Health under section 77.7 of the Health Protection and Promotion Act.</p>


<p>Inspection Finding The Licensee failed to ensure compliance with Directive #3 regarding COVID-19.</p>
<p>Outcome The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.</p>
<p>3. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 64; Police background checks.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p>64. (2) The screening measures shall include a police background check as defined in the regulations, unless the person being screened is under 18 years of age.</p>
<p>Inspection Finding There was no evidence to show that the screening measures for a staff member included a police record check.</p>
<p>Outcome The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.</p>
