Purpose of Inspection

<p><b>1. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 27; Infection prevention and control program.</b></p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p><b>27. (5)</b> The licensee of a retirement home shall ensure that,</p> <p>(0.b) all reasonable steps are taken in the retirement home to follow,</p> <p>(i) any directive respecting coronavirus (COVID-19) issued to long-term care homes by the Chief Medical Officer of Health under section 77.7 of the Health Protection and Promotion Act,</p> <p>(0.a) any guidance, advice or recommendations given to retirement homes by the Chief Medical Officer of Health are followed in the retirement home;</p>
<p><b>Inspection Finding</b></p> <p>The Licensee failed to follow recommendations given to retirement homes by the Chief Medical Officer of Health and failed to take reasonable steps to follow directives with respect to coronavirus (COVID-19) from the Chief Medical Officer of Health as it pertains to the screening of all essential visitors and proper use of PPE by staff.</p>
<p><b>Outcome</b></p> <p>The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.</p>
