Purpose of Inspection
The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the "RHA").


NON-COMPLIANCE
<p>1. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 27; Infection prevention and control program.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p>27. (1) Every licensee of a retirement home shall ensure that the infection prevention and control program required by paragraph 2 of subsection 60 (4) of the Act complies with the requirements in this section.</p> <p>27. (5) The licensee of a retirement home shall ensure that,</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">(0.b) all reasonable steps are taken in the retirement home to follow,</p> <p style="padding-left: 80px;">(i) any directive respecting coronavirus (COVID-19) issued to long-term care homes by the Chief Medical Officer of Health under section 77.7 of the Health Protection and Promotion Act,</p>
<p>Inspection Finding</p> <p>The Licensee's infection prevention and control policy, as shown at the inspection, did not include notification of the medical officer of health, or designate, of an increase in the number of symptomatic residents in the Home. In addition, there was insufficient evidence to confirm that the Licensee adhered to all of the requirements set out in Directive # 3 from the Chief Medical Officer of Health dated March 30, 2020, specifically evidence of staff screening for illness from the date specified.</p>
<p>Outcome</p> <p>The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.</p>

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.
