Purpose of Inspection
The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE
<p><b>1. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 62; Plan of care.</b></p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p><b>62. (1)</b> When a resident commences his or her residency in a retirement home, the licensee shall, within the prescribed times, ensure that the resident is assessed and that a plan of care is developed based on the assessment and in accordance with this section and the regulations.</p>
<p><b>Inspection Finding</b></p> <p>2 residents reviewed did not have plans of care.</p>
<p><b>Outcome</b></p> <p>The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.</p>
<p><b>2. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 27; Infection prevention and control program.</b></p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p><b>27. (5)</b> The licensee of a retirement home shall ensure that,</p> <p>(0.b) all reasonable steps are taken in the retirement home to follow,</p> <p>(i) any directive respecting coronavirus (COVID-19) issued to long-term care homes by the Chief Medical Officer of Health under section 77.7 of the Health Protection and Promotion Act,</p> <p>(ii) any guidance, advice or recommendations respecting coronavirus (COVID-19) that are given</p>

<p>to long-term care homes by the Chief Medical Officer of Health and made available on the Government of Ontario’s website respecting coronavirus (COVID-19); (0.a) any guidance, advice or recommendations given to retirement homes by the Chief Medical Officer of Health are followed in the retirement home;</p>
<p><b>Inspection Finding</b> The home was not consistently following all of the requirements.</p>
<p><b>Outcome</b> The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.</p>
