Purpose of Inspection
The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE

<p>Inspection Finding</p> <p>The Licensee did not ensure that a resident's plan of care was approved by a person acting under supervision of a member of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario or the College of Nurses of Ontario.</p>
<p>Outcome</p> <p>The Licensee took corrective action to achieve compliance.</p>
<p>2. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 29; Administration of drugs or other substances.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p>29. If one of the care services that the licensee or the staff of a retirement home provide to a resident of the home is the administration of a drug or other substance, the licensee shall ensure that,</p>

(c) neither the licensee nor a staff member administers a drug to a resident in the home unless the licensee or the staff member has received training in the procedures applicable to the administration of the drug;

Inspection Finding

The Licensee did not ensure that a staff member administering a drug to a resident in the home, had received training in the procedures applicable to the administration of the drug.

Outcome


The Licensee took corrective action to achieve compliance.

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.
