Purpose of Inspection
The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE

The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 74; Licensee's duty to respond to incidents of wrongdoing.</b></p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p><b>74.</b> Every licensee of a retirement home shall ensure that,</p> <p>(a) every alleged, suspected or witnessed incident of the following of which the licensee knows or that is reported to the licensee is immediately investigated:</p> <p>(i) abuse of a resident of the home by anyone,</p>
<p><b>Inspection Finding</b></p> <p>The Licensee did not ensure an allegation of abuse of a resident was properly investigated as it pertains to the documentation of the investigation.</p>
<p><b>Outcome</b></p> <p>The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.</p>
<p><b>2. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 62; Reassessment and revision.</b></p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p><b>62. (12)</b> The licensee shall ensure that the resident is reassessed and the plan of care reviewed and revised at least every six months and at any other time if, in the opinion of the licensee or the resident,</p>

**Inspection Finding**

Evidence at the time of inspection revealed that the licensee had not reassessed the resident or updated the plan of care within the prescribed timeframe.

**Outcome**

The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.
