

**REGISTRAR ORDER**  
**Under the *Retirement Homes Act, 2010***

<b>Order Information:</b> The Registrar issued a Management Order to the Licensee under section 91 of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the “Act”) and under the <i>Reopening Ontario (A Flexible Response to COVID-19) Act, 2020</i> . The Order requires the Licensee to retain a Manager to manage all operations of the Home. The Registrar believes on reasonable grounds that the Licensee cannot or will not properly operate the Home without assistance. The Registrar also believes on reasonable grounds that the Licensee has contravened certain sections of the Act and Ontario Regulation 166/11 (the “Regulation”) under the Act, pertaining the failure to implement the policies, precautions, and procedures to protect residents from exposure to coronavirus (COVID-19) as directed by the Chief Medical Officer of Health (“CMOH”) of the province of Ontario.
