Purpose of Inspection
The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE
<p><b>1. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 29; Administration of drugs or other substances.</b></p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p><b>29.</b> If one of the care services that the licensee or the staff of a retirement home provide to a resident of the home is the administration of a drug or other substance, the licensee shall ensure that,</p> <p>(e) if the licensee or a staff member is involved in the administration of the drug or other substance at the home, that the licensee or staff member is trained in,</p> <p>(ii) the safe disposal of syringes and other sharps,</p>
<p><b>Inspection Finding</b></p> <p>At the time of the inspection, the licensee was unable to provide evidence of UCP training, specifically, in the area of proper disposal of syringes and other sharps.</p>
<p><b>Outcome</b></p> <p>At the time of the inspection, the Licensee was not in compliance. The home has since taken corrective action to achieve compliance.</p>
<p><b>2. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 27; Infection prevention and control program.</b></p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p><b>27. (5)</b> The licensee of a retirement home shall ensure that,</p>

- (0.b) all reasonable steps are taken in the retirement home to follow,
- (i) any directive respecting coronavirus (COVID-19) issued to long-term care homes by the Chief Medical Officer of Health under section 77.7 of the Health Protection and Promotion Act,
  - (ii) any guidance, advice or recommendations respecting coronavirus (COVID-19) that are given to long-term care homes by the Chief Medical Officer of Health and made available on the Government of Ontario's website respecting coronavirus (COVID-19);

**Inspection Finding**

At the time of the inspection, the licensee was not in compliance with the CMOH Directive # 3, with regards to Residents with symptoms (including mild respiratory and/or atypical symptoms) must be isolated and tested for COVID-19.

**Outcome**

At the time of the inspection the Licensee was not in compliance. The home has since taken corrective action to achieve compliance.

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.
