Purpose of Inspection
The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE

(4) The licensee of a retirement home shall ensure that there is a written plan of care for each resident of the home that sets out,</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (b) the planned care services for the resident that the licensee will provide, including, <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) the details of the services, (ii) the goals that the services are intended to achieve, (iii) clear directions to the licensee's staff who provide direct care to the resident; <p>62. (12) The licensee shall ensure that the resident is reassessed and the plan of care reviewed and revised at least every six months and at any other time if, in the opinion of the licensee or the resident,</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (b) the resident's care needs change or the care services set out in the plan are no longer necessary;
<p>Inspection Finding</p> <p>The home failed to provide evidence that plans of care included details of the service, the goals the service is intended to achieve and clear directions for staff. In addition, the home failed to provide evidence that plans of care were updated to reflect the residents current care needs, as required in the legislation.</p>
<p>Outcome</p> <p>The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.</p>
