Purpose of Inspection
The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the "RHA").


NON-COMPLIANCE
<p><b>1. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 27; Infection prevention and control program.</b></p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p><b><u>27. (5)</u></b> The licensee of a retirement home shall ensure that,</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">(0.b) all reasonable steps are taken in the retirement home to follow,</p> <p style="padding-left: 80px;">(i) any directive respecting coronavirus (COVID-19) issued to long-term care homes by the Chief Medical Officer of Health under section 77.7 of the Health Protection and Promotion Act,</p>
<p><b>Inspection Finding</b></p> <p>The licensee of a retirement home failed to ensure that, all reasonable steps are taken in the retirement home to follow any directive respecting coronavirus (COVID-19) issued to retirement homes by the Chief Medical Officer of Health under section 77.7 of the Health Protection and Promotion Act. Specifically, the home was not abiding by the recommendations for parameters surrounding short term absences and access to visitation by essential caregivers and general visitors.</p>
<p><b>Outcome</b></p> <p>At the time of the inspection, the Licensee was not in compliance. The home has since taken corrective action to achieve compliance.</p>

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.
