Purpose of Inspection
The RHRA conducts routine inspections as set out in section 77(3) of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE
<p>1. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 27; Infection prevention and control program.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p>27. (5) The licensee of a retirement home shall ensure that,</p> <p>(0.b) all reasonable steps are taken in the retirement home to follow,</p> <p>(i) any directive respecting coronavirus (COVID-19) issued to long-term care homes by the Chief Medical Officer of Health under section 77.7 of the Health Protection and Promotion Act,</p>
<p>Inspection Finding</p> <p>The staff of the Licensee failed to fully screen the inspector, as well as two subsequent visitors entering the Home, following the questionnaire issued by the Ministry of Health for screening, and as per Directive # 3 as issued by the Chief Medical Officer of Health.</p>
<p>Outcome</p> <p>The Licensee submitted a plan to achieve compliance by May 13, 2021. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.</p>
<p>2. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 24; Emergency plan, general.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p>24. (5) The licensee shall,</p> <p>(b) at least once every two years, conduct a planned evacuation of the retirement home;</p>

<p>Inspection Finding</p> <p>The staff of the Licensee confirmed that a full evacuation of the facility has not been conducted in the past two year period, as prescribed.</p>
<p>Outcome</p> <p>The Licensee submitted a plan to achieve compliance by May 19, 2021. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.</p>

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the “RHRA”) and the home’s Residents’ Council, if any.
