Purpose of Inspection

<p>Inspection Finding</p> <p>The resident's plan of care did not mention their risk or history of falls as required by the legislation.</p>
<p>Outcome</p> <p>At the time of the inspection, the Licensee was not in compliance. The home has since taken corrective action to achieve compliance.</p>
